CREATE YOUR PERSONAL GIVING PAGE

- 1. Go to: bit.ly/runwalkroll2023
- 2. Click on the orange 'Start Fundraising" button on the bottom right.
- 3. Sign up for an account by entering your name, email, and password. Then click the purple "Sign up" button. If you already have an account, log in.
- 4. Complete your profile by entering your address and clicking "Continue".
- 5. On the next page, you can **choose a personalized URL** for your fundraising page web address. The default will be your first name – last name. Then click "Create your page".
- 6. You can "Edit your page" to personalize it with your own photo and personal story or you can leave it as is.

CREATE YOUR TEAM PAGE

- 1. Once you've created a personal page, click on the blue "Create a team" text under your page name.
- 2. Type in your "Team Name" in the box and click on the purple "Create a Team". Then, click the purple "Continue" button.
- 3. Again, you can remove the default photo to add your own photo and personalize your Team Story. Click continue or skip this step.
- 4. Set your team fundraising goal, personalize your Team page URL link, then click "Create your team" to finish the process.
- 5. Visit your team page to share via Facebook, Twitter, or Email. You can also messenger a link or copy your team link to share.
- 6. You have done it! You are a Team Captain and you are building an all-star team of fundraisers to join you in supporting
- 7. Inclusion Matters by Shane's Inspiration. Congratulations! Now, let's get to fundraising for #InclusionMatters!

DAY OF EVENT DETAILS

The event takes place on Sunday, September 17, 2023, at Shane's Inspiration Playground in Griffith Park.

Registration begins at 7:00 am. Parking is in Merry-Go-Round Lots 1, 2, or 3. Free event T-shirts will be given to each participant when they check in.

The Exhibition Fair Opens at 7:00 am.

Gather your teammates to take a free Team Photo before the Walk & Roll. Allow for enough time to get to the event site and park. Consider designating a meeting place as a group for your team photo.

Check out all the activities. Enjoy refreshments, visit our exhibition fair, and participate in our free raffle! As team members may want to do different activities, consider designating a meeting time and place to start the walk; as well as, a place to meet after the walk, in case you get split up. The Opening Ceremony is at 8:00 am. A warm-up will take place at 8:20 am.
